

Our goal this year is to receive \$2.4M to support the big vision that we have discerned together. Thank you in advance for the blessing of your gifts! Together, we can get this done!





oundry's Social Justice ministries are focused on both meeting the immediate physical needs of our neighbors and community and justice—organizing, advocating, and providing education that affects systematic change.

- We put our mission into action by showing up and advocating for justice for God's kin-dom.
- Significant progress was made at the General Conference in May 2024, where 94% of delegates in attendance approved a consent calendar to remove discriminatory language from the Book of Discipline. This change lifts the ban on ordaining LGBTQIA+ clergy and eliminates penalties for clergy and churches that host same-sex weddings.
- We are also always a presence at DC Pride, with our famous lemonade stand at 16th and P.

ur Racial Justice Ministry Team works to support and help equip the Foundry community to build awareness around racial inequalities and opt into active dialogue and action towards racial justice.

- For over 20 years, ID Ministry has been helping people acquire social security cards, birth certificates, and photo identification. The team serves over 1,500 people per year.
- We have Cooking Ministry Teams that work both at Foundry and in the community to prepare meals for neighbors in need.

- Our Sacred Resistance
 Team educates, organizes, and empowers the Foundry community for advocacy and public witness addressing various social justice issues we are facing at both the local and national levels.
- Foundry offers volunteer-led English as a Second Language (ESL) classes on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6:45-8:30 p.m. These classes are free and open to students 17 years and older.
- Founded in 1999, DC Books to
 Prisons is a volunteer-run 501(c)
 (3) non-profit organization that
 provides free books to individual
 prisoners and supports prison
 libraries.



 Foundry works with Literacy Programs through Project Transformation. Our community partners include Washington Interfaith Network, The Way Home Campaign, and Congregation Action Network.

Twice a year, Foundry engages in a congregation-wide Great Day of Service.

- In the spring, we work with Rise Against Hunger to pack thousands of meals for communities in need across the globe.
- In the fall, we engage in a Green Day of Service, partnering in the past with Casey Trees, Rock Creek Conservancy and the Potomac

Conservancy to help remove invasive plants, plant native ones, and clean up the Potomac River.



- We also offer numerous opportunities to serve our congregation, community, and the world. Whether through volunteering or participating in various initiatives, your contributions make a real, tangible difference.



WHY MAKE AN ESTIMATED CONTRIBUTION FOR 2025?

At Foundry, our single most important source of funding for our ministries comes from the estimated giving contributions during our annual stewardship campaign. Unlike some churches, we receive virtually no funds from an endowment. We are deeply grateful for the faithfulness of our congregation, as we have consistently received, at a minimum - a 90 percent fulfillment rate for all promised commitments. These commitments provide us with a forecast on which we can build our expense budget for the coming year. We acknowledge each gift to be as unique as the individual giver, and we strive to be exceptional stewards of the resources entrusted to us.
